# HOHLOHIS Classroom

We have been exploring the history and culture of Native Americans and Pilgrims:

•Reading Native American legends

- •Learning about Native American appreciation of nature and respect for the planet.
- Creating clay coil pots, leather work, art, water color paintings representing nature from paints made from plants, noodle necklaces, nature collage
- •Learning about life on the Mayflower and Pilgrims
- •Learning about Thanksgiving
- •Baking pumpkin pie

Many children are beginning to spell words: no, yes, cat, dog. We have learned these upper and lowercase letters; Ee, Ff, Hh, Jj, Ll, Nn, P,p and Tt. Many children now recognize these letters, letter sounds and words beginning with these letters.

We are continuing to explore changes in nature. We have been exploring patters, creating sets 106, and sequencing numbers 1-10 and writing numbers, adding sets together and what is before and after.
