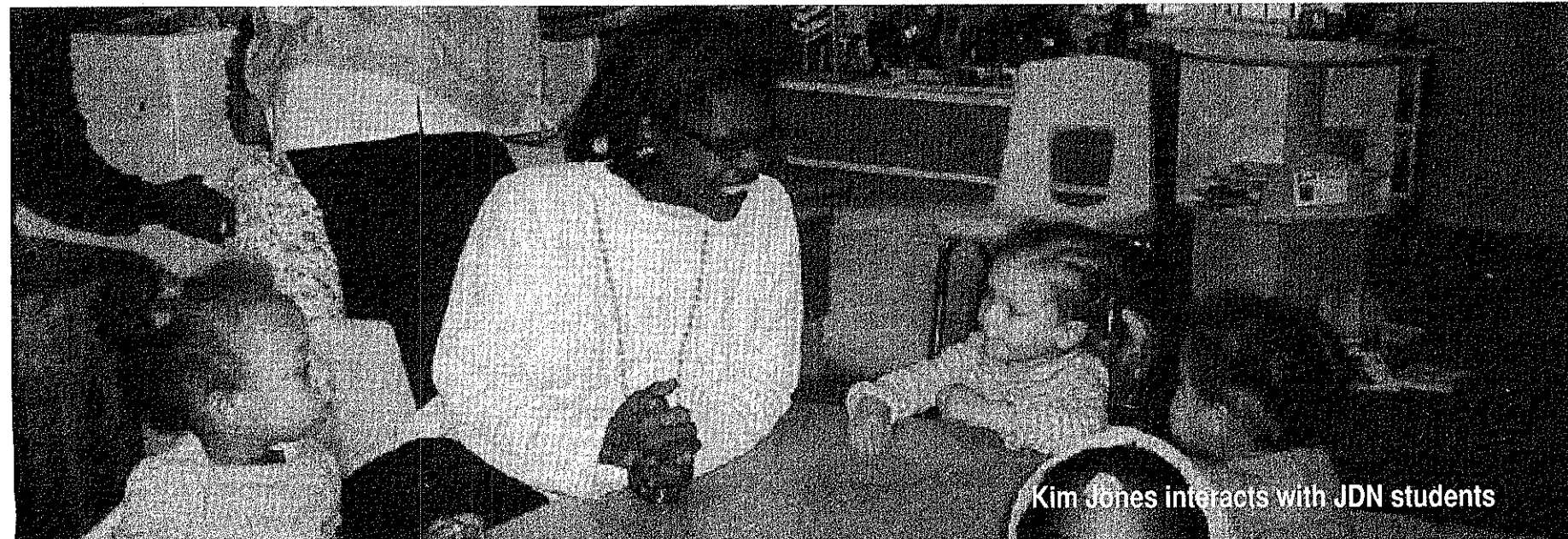


Jenkintown Day Nursery appoints new assistant director
